LIMITED WARRANTY LIFETIME WARRANTY

The seat foam, reclining mechanism, all other metal parts and the wooden frame parts in this furniture are warranted to be free of defects in workmanship and materials for the lifetime of the mechanism or frame, as the case may be. "Lifetime" means the normal, useful life as determined by the manufacturer.

FIVE YEAR WARRANTY

Sleeper mattresses are warranted to be free of defects in workmanship and materials for a period of five years from the date of sale to the original purchaser.

ONE YEAR WARRANTY

UPHOLSTERED FABRICS

Fabric and leather are warranted to be free of defects in materials and workmanship for one year from the date of sale. This warranty covers seam failure, fabric separation and nap loss. This warranty DOES NOT apply to pilling, fading, shrinking, dyelot variations, tears, scratching, fraying, stretching, wearing or flattening of nap. Chenilles, Velvets and Velvet types have an inherent soft texture and will crush, shade and mark easier than most fabrics and these characteristics are not considered a defect. Also excluded are damages and defects resulting from abuse, neglect, exposure to extreme temperatures or humidity, alterations, burns, cuts, scuffs, watermarks, indentions or pet damage. Natural markings such as scars, brands, grain variations, wrinkles, etc, will be considered normal characteristics and not construed as defects. No two leather hides are ever the same so color variations could occur. Where there is evidence of excessive soiling, improper cleaning, abuse or where the fabric/leather has had some form of chemical applied, the fabric /leather warranty will not apply. Franklin Corporation at its discretion may require proof of damage.

ELECTRONICS

All electrical components and reclining power motors are warranted to be free of defects in workmanship and materials for a period of one year from the date of sale to the original purchaser. All lift chair motors have a 3-year warranty.

FURNITURE COMPONENTS

All other furniture components such as handles and legs are warranted to be free of defects in workmanship and material for a period of one year from the date of sale to the original purchaser.

LIMITATIONS ON WARRANTY

The warranty contained herein shall be in lieu of any other warranty, express or implied, including but not limited to any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular use. Liability for incidental or consequential damages under the warranty is excluded. Some states do not allow limitation of incidental or consequential damages; therefore this limitation may not apply to you. This warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights that vary from state to state. The following additional limitations apply to all warranties contained herein:


- 1. Warranties extend to the original purchaser only and are not transferable.

Cost of packing and shipping the entire piece to and from the factory, if necessary, is not covered by this warranty. Any merchandise deemed not repairable by the manufacturer will be prorated through the dealer based on the original date of purchase.



- 2. Close the recliner completely before you get up.
- 3. Never sit on the ottoman (foot rest) when open.
- 4. Do not sit on the arms of the recliner.
- 5. Use caution in operating the reclining mechanism when small children and pets are present.
- 6. Do not allow children to play on or operate mechanized furniture.
- 7. Keep hands and feet clear of the reclining mechanism and all moving parts.
- 8. Completely close and secure the reclining mechanism before moving motion furniture.
- WARNING: Avoid exposing upholstered furniture to burning cigarettes or cigars, open flames and high temperatures.
- Do not place furniture with wooden bases on wet carpet as staining may occur.
- 11. Excessive rocking may cause a recliner to tip over possibly resulting in personal injury and/or property damage.
- If the furniture contains electrical components use with extreme caution and see the enclosed Safety Instructions for additional instructions and warnings.
- 13. Do not exceed recommended weight limit.



FABRIC CARE

We use only the finest upholstery materials because the beauty of your furniture depends on its cover. Soiled areas should be cleaned as advised by the fabric manufacturer based on the following codes:

- WS Clean with shampoo, foam or dry cleaning solvents as desired. Do not saturate with liquid. Pile fabrics may require brushing to restore appearance. Cushion covers should not be removed and dry-cleaned or laundered.
- W Clean only with water-based shampoo or foam upholstery cleaner. Do not over wet. Do not use solvents to spot clean. Pile fabrics may require brushing to restore appearance. Cushion covers should not be removed and laundered.
- S Clean only with dry-cleaning solvent. Do not saturate. Do not use water, Pile fabrics may require brushing to restore appearance. Cushion covers should not be removed and dry-cleaned.
- X Do not clean with either water or solvent based cleaner. Use vacuuming or light brushing only.
- V This material should be washed with mild soap in warm water only. Do not use full-strength soap or liquid cleaning agents of any type.
